As written in the grant, we are expected to offer professional development for your librarians and/or aides.

The first professional development workshop will begin at 9:00 AM at Mid Central Educational Cooperative on Thursday, October 19. We will complete our work by 3:00 PM. **The primary objective of this workshop is to examine titles and develop books lists related to content standards.** This is extremely important to the professionals developing orders for the Library Grant. The grant will pay mileage for one school vehicle and lodging for those librarians who live more than 150 miles from Platte. Lunch will be provided. It is mandatory for each school to send at least one representatives to this workshop. I have reserved four rooms at the Dakota Country Inn in Platte for Wednesday October 18th. Their phone number is 3372607. If you want one of those rooms, contact them by Wednesday October 11 or the rooms will be released. Ask for one of the rooms reserved by Mid Central Educational Cooperative.

The second professional development workshop will begin at 9:00 AM at Mid Central Educational Cooperative on Thursday, November 2. **The primary objective of this workshop is to examine the online databases provided by the State Library.** Those individuals who are working the additional access hours for your grant need to attend with the librarians/aides. This in-service will be presented by Julie Erickson the Electronic Services Coordinator for the South Dakota State Library. We will pay mileage for one school vehicle and lodging for those who live more than 150 miles away from Platte. Lunch will be provided. While you are staying at Dakota Country Inn in Platte for the first workshop, please make your reservations for Wednesday, November 1 if you will need a room.
